I joined the newspaper to stop the spread of slander and libel.

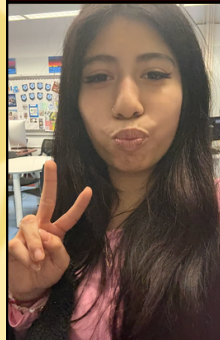

I want to learn some life skills and see what's possible.

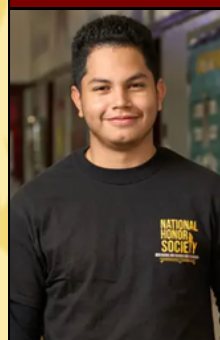
